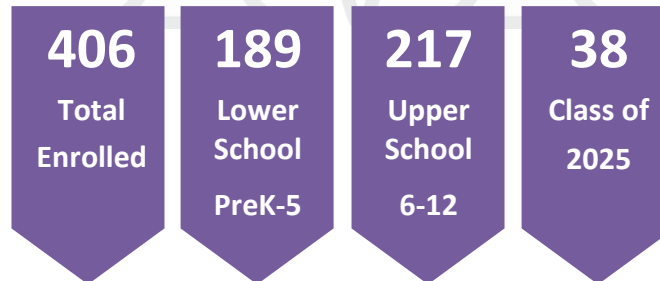
OUR SCHOOL

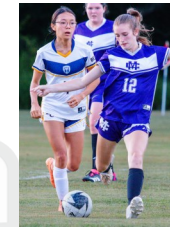
