Job Description

Job Title: Intervention Services Instructor

This position will report to the Intervention Services Director to provide assistance and instruction to students with an accommodation plan.

Qualifications

- A bachelor's degree is required; experience is preferred.
- Obtain/maintain teacher certification from the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) or hold a valid state licensure and be willing to complete ACSI's Philosophy of Christian Education course and the required Bible CEUs.
- Be a Christian who is growing in his/her relationship to Christ.
- Adhere to the Statement of Faith and the Biblical Lifestyle Statement of Maryville Christian School.
- Maintain active membership in an evangelical church. Continually seek ways to further his/her spiritual growth through regular church attendance, Bible studies, etc.
- Demonstrate the qualities of enthusiasm, courtesy, flexibility, integrity, gratitude, kindness, self-control, perseverance, punctuality, organization, and professionalism.
- Have a passion for serving God in the context of Christian education and pray regularly for students, parents, and staff.
- Able to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing.
- Respectfully submit to and be loyal to constituted authority.

General Responsibilities

- Contribute to the team effort of the faculty and staff to best meet the spiritual, physical, and mental needs of the overall student body.
- Maintain a strict level of confidentiality of information regarding students and staff.
- Exercise considerable independent judgment and discretion in applying Christian standards to a variety of work situations.
- Handle tasks assigned by the Intervention Services Director or students' teachers.
- Monitor student behavior inside and outside of the classroom, always supporting and maintaining the classroom rules and standards.
- Reinforce teachers' rules and behavior standards in a positive, encouraging manner.
- Attend faculty and staff meetings as required by the principal and/or head of school.
- Assist with extracurricular duties as assigned by the principal and/or head of school.

Specific Responsibilities

- Incorporate Biblical principles throughout the curriculum and daily routine.
- Communicate the needs of the student and concerns for the student to the teachers.
- Provide student support in the classroom for K-5th grade students with an accommodation.
- Provide instruction for and/or reteach students with an accommodation as needed.
- Assist in providing accommodations.
- Have considerable knowledge of the philosophy and objectives of Christian education and of the standard resources, materials, practices, and facilities utilized in a comprehensive Christian educational program and special education program.
- Demonstrate effectiveness in presenting subjects in a way that frames students' thinking from multiple angles using a variety of evidence, offers secular and Biblical worldviews, and equips students with the tools and perspectives to think for themselves.
- Employ a variety of instructional aids, methods, and materials that will provide for creative and differentiated teaching to reach the whole child: spiritual, mental, physical, and social.
- Collaborate with department, middle and high school teams, and administration around student progress.
- Show a love of learning that translates into a positive environment that is conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of the students.
- Exhibit a passion for equipping students to think critically, solve problems, and exercise self-discipline.
